The Falls City City Council met in special session on Monday, August 1, 2022 at 6:02 p.m. via Zoom.

Homelessness MOU</li> </ol>		<p>Mr. Foscoli gave a brief staff report covering all three items in the consent agenda.</p> <p>It was moved by Council President Houghtaling to approve the Consent Agenda. The motion was duly seconded by Councilor Jirovec and carried with a vote of 5-0 with Council President Houghtaling, Councilors Backus, Jirovec, D Sickles, and LJ Sickles voting YES.</p>	
Good of the Order		<p>Mr. Foscoli reported that the wastewater effluent drainage has slowed to the point that it is affecting the football field because the system is processing 4 times as much sewage than normal. He noted he would like to coordinate with local agencies and the school district to find a solution.</p> <p>Councilor Dennis Sickles voiced his concern due to football practice starting in August. Councilor Jirovec asked if the area was safe and needed to be cordoned off from people accessing it. Mr. Foscoli stated that as long as someone isn't rolling around on the ground it isn't a major hazard.</p> <p>Council President Houghtaling asked who had been contacted at the school district. Mr. Foscoli mentioned he had spoken with John Gilbert and emailed Superintendent Cory Ellis.</p> <p>Council President Houghtaling asked that an email string be created to keep Mr. Ellis, Mr. Gilbert, and Councilor Dennis Sickles informed of the process. Mr. Foscoli stated he wanted to have a meeting with all players and come up with a solution.</p>	

	<p>Mr. Foscoli stated an electric vehicle would be in Falls City on August 8 before the Council meeting for all the Councilors to view and test drive for a possible city vehicle. He reported that Falls City had passed the first level for consideration for a 1.6 million grant to reinforce water intake on Gayle and Teal creek. He noted the candidate forum would be at Spirit Mountain Casino on August 9 at 11:30 am.</p> <p>Mayor Bailey announced that the Pride Festival was this coming weekend and that a representative from the American Ramp Co would be in Falls City on August 9 to view the skate park site.</p>
