Storm Water Awareness

Washing Cars and Boats

- Take your car or boat to your local car wash. The water at these facilities is discharged to the sanitary sewer which is treated.
- If you must wash at home, wash on a vegetated surface using organic soaps without phosphates.

Automotive Repair

- Never change your oil or do auto repair in the street.
- Clean spills with absorbent material or sprinkle with kitty litter, then sweep and throw in the trash.
- Collect used oil, antifreeze, and leftover petroleum products and recycle appropriately.
