NEW 4-Way Stop coming to Falls City!

There's a new <u>4-Way Stop</u> coming to the intersection at <u>Bridge Street & S. Main Street/Parry Road</u> (next to the <u>Resource Center</u> building on the Mill Lot) This traffic pattern change was approved by the Public Works Commission and City Council to enhance traffic safety at an intersection that has seen an uptick in pedestrian traffic. Please be aware of pedestrians going to and from the Resource Center, and we ask for your collaboration in slowing down and **coming to a full stop while traveling through this intersection**.

Upper Park Trees

The city has been informed by the Oregon Department of Forestry that five of trees in the George Kitchin Park are diseased and will need to be cut down for residents' safety. We are working very hard to make sure that these trees will not only be brought down safely, but that they will be replaced by fast-growing trees.
