8. Correspondence, Comments and Ex-Officio Reports **Comments:**

PLEASE RECONSIDER: These (from the June 16 meeting) were not addressed at the last City Council meeting, so here is a rehash:

- 1) *Will Cleek asked if we can set up 'Doggie Doo Doo Bag Stations' and 'Clean up after your dog' signs at various places in the park. The Parents Group just had their first*

movie night at the Upper Park last week. He said he spent half an hour cleaning up poop. Larry said it is a perpetual problem. This is something for the City Council.

- 2) *The bathroom 'renovations' at the Upper Park: what did they do and how much did we spend on it? Will shared about a dozen pictures of the sloppy workmanship on the door, noting that the outside door appeared to be hollow core which is for indoor use only. The sink is poorly hung, the dry wall beneath is crumbling, there are gaps in the wall, if they painted, they only did some of it. He can supply the photos to the council or request. The Parks committee said they'd like to know how much was paid for the repairs/upgrades on the restrooms and would like to see the scope of work the contractor said they provided, and who signed off on the work. Dennis Sickles suggested a community clean up crew for the bathrooms.*
