Accepted Items:

- General Junk
- Scrap Metal
- Empty clean appliances
- Electronics
- Yard debris- No dirt or sod
- Tires (for a fee)

Items not accepted:

- Boats, vehicles:
anything that requires a title
- Household garbage
- Liquids
- Hazardous waste including batteries
- Brick, dirt, sod, concrete
- Coolers or appliances with rancid contents

Curbside pick-up will be available for seniors and disabled community members. To add your name to the list call 503.787.3631 by June 1st, 2021.

Items must be left on the public right-of-way, not on the road. Unassigned piles will not be picked up by volunteers.
