Backflow Testing Fee

Council voted in favor of the city no longer maintaining private backflow testing devices. What does this mean for property owners in Falls City?

Per OAR 333-061-0070, residents will be responsible for having their own backflow devices tested every 12 months and providing the results to the city. If your device fails, it will need to be repaired or replaced, and retested. Residents' backflow devices were tested by the city in 2023, devices will need to be tested at the homeowners' expense during the calendar year 2024. A list of local backflow testing companies and an overview of the reporting program will be sent out with utility bills in the next few months.

The backflow testing fee was removed from monthly utility bills in March of 2024, and a \$4.50 credit was issued for January and February.
