As well as striping the 5-foot pedestrian path striping to the Elementary School.

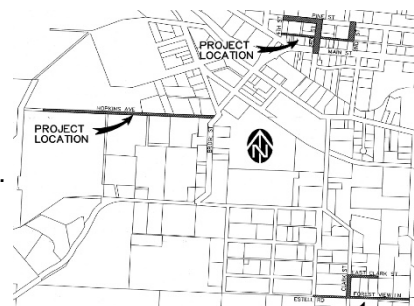


Waterline Replacement Project

Construction on Phase 1 is complete!

This project's new water lines on Hopkins Avenue, as well as the lines on Estelle, Clark, East Clark, and Forest View Lane are online. The lines on 2nd, 3rd, 4th and Pine Street, as well as the alley between Pine Street & N. Main Street are also online.

The Contractor, Trench Line Excavation, still needs to pave over some portions of road, but will work hard to keep roads from being fully closed. In the new year, sections of Parry, Terrace, Fairview, Cameron, Mill, & 1st Streets will be upgraded as part of Phase 2.
