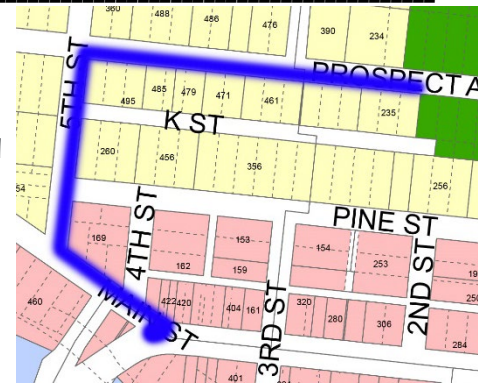
The Resource Center building on the Mill Lot on the corner of Bridge St. and Parry has a lot going on! Stop by and explore all this center has to offer each day throughout the month.

Construction will take place from August to October

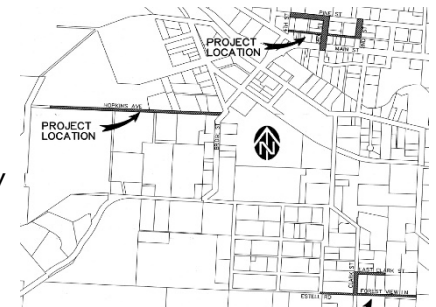
North Santiam Paving has begun work on the pedestrian island and curb improvement work at Bridge/ N. Main/ Mitchell Streets. The work will then proceed up Mitchell, then to 5th St., finally to Prospect. The whole project should be less than 120 days. The 5-foot widening of 5th and Prospect streets for a pedestrian path is complete with striping soon to come.



Waterline Replacement Project

Construction will take place from August thru October

This project's new water lines on Hopkins Avenue are ready for testing! Ongoing are 2nd, 3rd, 4th and Pine Street, as well as the alley between Pine Street & N. Main Street, and including Estelle, Clark, East Clark, and Forest View Lane. The Contractor, Trench Line Excavation, has been working very hard to keep roads from being fully closed, and residential access has been maintained throughout the construction.
