On August 18, 2020 City Manager, Mac Corthell tendered his resignation. The City Council has named David Clyne, a 30+ year City Manager, and the former Manager of Independence, as the Manager Pro-Tem as required by the City Charter. Mr. Clyne, if his contract is approved, will keep operations and projects moving forward while working with the City Council to define a process for selecting a new permanent City Manager. Mr. Corthell's final day will be September 18, 2020.
